Informa Systems selected to Implement Certification and Training System for the Commonwealth of Virginia

Virginia Department of Criminal Justice Services (VDCJS) is tasked with managing the certification of criminal justice personnel in the Commonwealth of Virginia. VDCJS oversees approximately 40 academies and 400 agencies and is responsible for the certification of over 50,000 officers. VDCJS selected InformaOne from Informa Systems to manage the training and certification, and also to provide each academy with the software tools to manage scheduling, enrollment, rostering and certification.



VDCJS has to manage over 30 certifications covering everything from full time law enforcement to drug recognition.

The InformaOne process allows certifications to be managed from enrollment, to certification, to expiration and re-certification.

The process is seamless and is made easy to visualize using the flowchart tools where every steps along the certification journey is mapped.

40 Academies are managed using the InformaOne software. Every Academy will login and manage their own calendar and invite Officers from Agencies to their training. Every Officer will have the ability to login and access their training calendar, see their transcripts and their certification status. Officers will also be notified of coming Certificate expirations.

Overall the system will take many separate system and incorporate into a single solution for the management of Certification and Learning for all 50,000 Officers at the Commonwealth of Virginia.
